The Great Contrast

1. Adam

Romans 5:12,15-19,23, Psalm 51:5, Genesis 2:15-17, 1:28-30, 3:17-19, 3:23-24

- The Event – Sin entered the world through one man
- The Result – Judgement and condemnation
- The Effect – Death reigned over man
 - 3 kinds of death:
 - Physical
 - Spiritual
 - Eternal
- The Reason – Disobedience
- The Loss – Position and authority

2. Christ

Romans 5:15-19, Hebrews 12:2, Revelation 5:9-10, John 10:10, Philippians 2:8-9, Luke 23:39-43, Matthew 28:18, Luke 10:19, Mark 16:17, Ephesians 2:6, John 14:12

- The Event – Christ and his cross
- The Result – Justification
- The Effect – Life reigns
- The Reason – A loving obedience
- The Gain – Position and authority

1. Whom do you take after most in your personality or temperament, your mother or your father, or perhaps one guardian in comparison to the other? What about talents and abilities? What about hobbies?

Read Romans 5:12-21.

2. Paul's logic of "how much more" continues in his contrast between Adam and Jesus in Romans 5:12-17. How is the work of Jesus far beyond the effect of the sin of Adam?
3. In Romans 5:15-16, Paul explains the difference between Adam's sin and Christ's gift. How were they different in their influence? Which do you think is greater? Why?
4. How was Adam's sin different from Christ's grace in how it was passed on to us? (See Romans 5:15-16)
5. How does Romans 5:18-21 summarize the entire letter of Romans so far?
6. Have you been justified, "resulting in eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord"? (Romans 5:21, NLT)
