### I. Released from the law

- Death is required to be released from the law
- Union in Christ's death releases you from the old law

### II. Belonging to God

- Union in Christ's resurrection frees you to belong to him
- Belonging: from rules to relationship

### III. Empowered by the Spirit

- The solution to the heart's problem
- Sanctification is made possible
- To bear fruit

## LIFE GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS

For the week of October 18, 2020

1. What is the longest (timewise) contract or lease agreement you have been involved in? How did it end? Did you have to buy out of the agreement? Explain.

2. Put Paul's marriage analogy into your own words. What point is he making? How is the marriage analogy related to his discussion on the law?

3. What does "the law" mean to us today: Working for God's favor? Earning our salvation? Following rules? Other?

4. How would you describe the differences between the two types of fruit mentioned in Romans 7:4-5? Give some examples of how you have seen each type of fruit recently.

5. According to Paul, followers of Christ are released from the law in union with Christ's death (through baptism). But why? Why are followers of Christ released from the law? (See verse 6) Why is it important to remember this reason?
