No Condemnation!

Romans 8:1-11

Understanding the Passage:

- God liberates us from the power of sin precisely in the **death** of Christ and the **life** of the Spirit.
Romans 8:1-4
- There is a sharp distinction between a mind-set controlled by the **flesh** and a mind-set controlled by the **Holy Spirit**.
Romans 8:5-8
- The indwelling Holy Spirit works to give **moral life now** and **resurrection life** in the **future**.
Romans 8:9-11

Taking this Passage Home:

1. **I am no longer condemned; I have been set free!**
Romans 8:1-2
2. **My mind-set matters**
Romans 12:1-2, Philippians 4:8
3. **Walk in the Spirit**
Galatians 5:16-26

LIFE GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS

For the week of November 15, 2020

1. As you look back on the Romans series and what we have covered thus far, what new things have you learned? What themes or topics have resonated most with you and why?

Read Romans 8:1-11 (as a Life Group or Individually)

2. In your own words, summarize what you believe Romans 8:1-4 is saying about what God did for us? Why are followers of Christ no longer condemned?
3. This week's passage ends with a promise in Romans 8:11: *"And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you."* How does this promise effect the way you think about the Holy Spirit? What kind of assurance or security does this verse bring about?

4. This week Pastor Brandon discussed the significance of the mind-set controlled by the Spirit. *Read Romans 12:1-2 and Philippians 4:8.* How do these passages help us get an understanding of a mind-set controlled by the Spirit? What are you doing to cultivate a mind-set that is controlled by the Spirit?

5. One of the take home points from this message is simple yet complex: "walk in the Spirit." How would you describe what it means to "walk in the Spirit"? *Read Galatians 5:16-26.* What are the glaring differences between the flesh and the Spirit in this text?
