Romans 9:1-33

1. Why were the Jews God's chosen people?

Romans 9:3, Genesis 12:1-3

2. What is the basis that led God to choose Israel?

- Salvation is based on God's grace, not our race
Romans 9:6-7, 2:28, 3:9, 4:16
- Salvation is based on God's Promise, not our preference
Romans 9:8-9
- Salvation is based on God's providence, not our performance.

- Salvation is based on God's mercy, not our merit.
